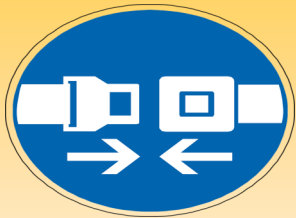

OUTLYING AREA TO THE CITY OF LAMAR
One way or round trip from Holly, Granada,
Bristol, Hartman or Wiley to the City of
Lamar is a suggested fare donation of
\$6.00 per person. Rides in the City of
Lamar will be \$1.50 per person per stop.
Bus will stop at designated stops only.

BUS ETIQUETTE

Passengers are to remain in their seats
while the bus is in motion.

Please be courteous of other passengers
Rudeness and/or vulgar language is
unacceptable and will result in removal
from the bus.

The front of the bus is reserved for
individuals with disabilities.

Be ready for your ride EARLY. Watches and
clocks seldom agree and an error of time
may result in a missed bus. We use a
'window' of 15 minutes before and after
the scheduled time of pickup to be at the
required location.
